Collect Art

Historic house. Folk Art Porch entrance

Visit the historic house to view the art collection and treasures of Bayou Bend. Along the way, complete an activity that allows you to become the curator of your own mini-exhibition within the collection! You'll also learn stories of American children who became artists.

Build a historical wooden toy, sew a needlework picture, and make a print in our printing press.

Archaeology Dig

Explore a simulation of an archaeology dig site. Items found in these sites include ceramics, metals, and more. You'll find out what these objects can tell us about people in the past.

Story Program

Cool off in the air conditioning and come hear tales of artists and the works they create. Readings are ongoing and participatory, and perfect for our youngest visitors.

Play a game with early American crafts on our interactive smartboard.

Diana Terrace


Chat with an artist creating a portrait painting, and discover the skills and techniques of an advanced artist.
