



Enhanced Health and Safety Protocols


**Face Mask

Junior School enhanced health and safety protocols include, but are not limited to:

- Face masks fully covering mouth and nose are required and must be worn at all times while on campus.
- All students, faculty, staff, and visitors must have their temperature taken upon entry. Anyone with a high temperature (low-grade or otherwise) will not be allowed to enter.
- All students, faculty, staff, and visitors are asked to self-report on illness, exposure, or if anyone in the same household is under quarantine, and to self-quarantine for up to 14 days.
- Anyone exhibiting COVID-19 or flu- or cold-like symptoms (including, but not limited to, fever, cough, congestion, shortness of breath, fatigue, nausea or vomiting, or loss of taste or smell) must quarantine at home for up to 14 days.
- Anyone who has tested positive, or who may have come into contact with someone who has tested positive, must quarantine at home for up to 14 days.
- All classrooms will operate at a reduced capacity to allow for social distancing.
- Desks in classrooms will be arranged to allow for social distancing between students, and restroom breaks will be staggered appropriately.
- Glassell facilities are cleaned and sanitized throughout the day, with extra attention to high-touch surfaces like faucets and door handles.
- Hand-sanitizing stations can be found in the main lobbies. Classrooms are stocked with hand sanitizer, disinfecting cleansers, and antibacterial hand soap. Hand washing will be repeated throughout the day.

Please note: By registering for class, students are committing to wearing a mask at all times in the school building and to following all current and future safety measures.
