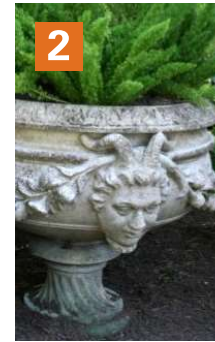

These peacocks nestle under shade-loving ferns, with a view over the ravine.



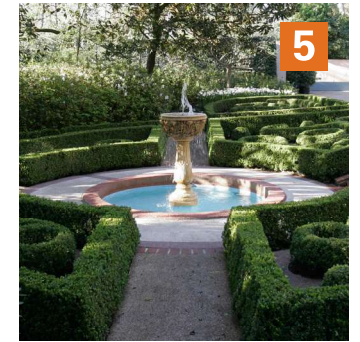
This face is a composite, or mix. What animal feature does the man have?



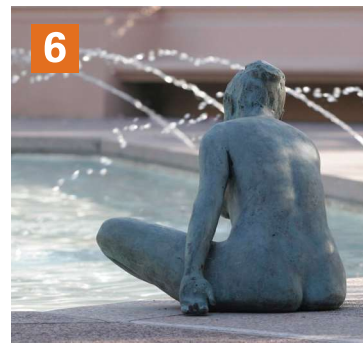
Lady Gandes watches over the French Baroque garden. Can you find her?

Mrs. Parker's Fountain is surrounded by green azalea bushes that have white blossoms in the spring.



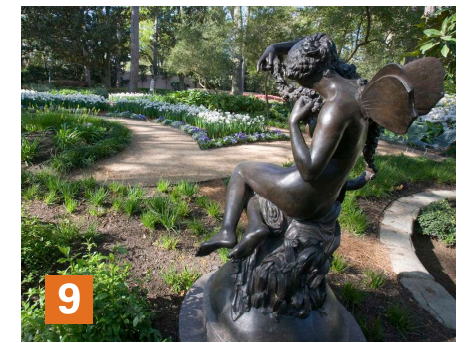
This contemplative, or thoughtful, lady watches over Rienzi's pool.
